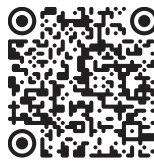


Dogs and other animals are not permitted in the museum (with the exception of guide dogs and assistance dogs).

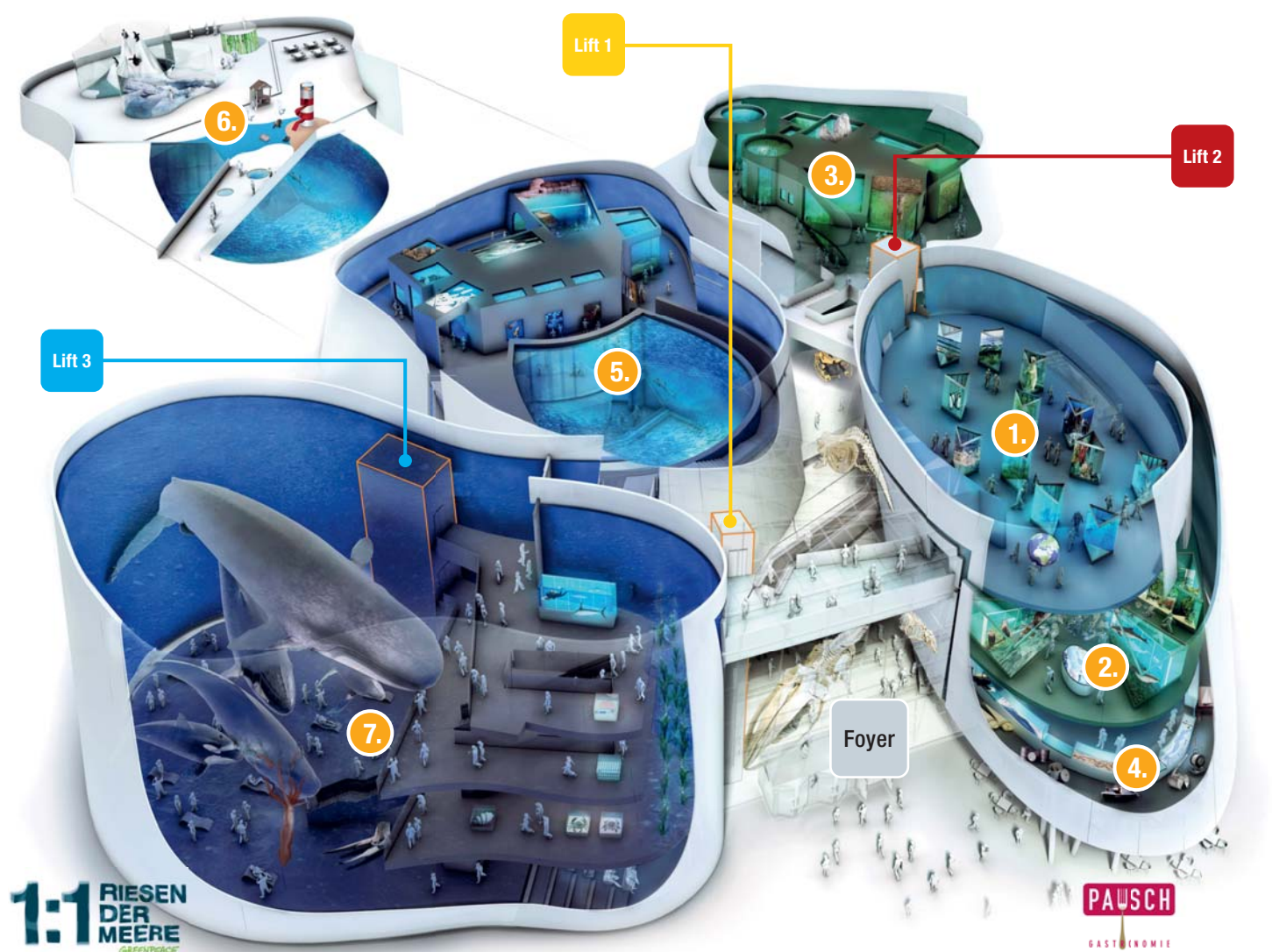

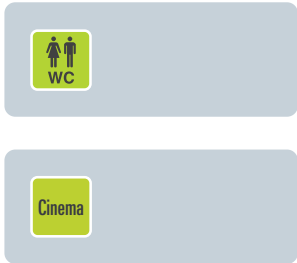
